



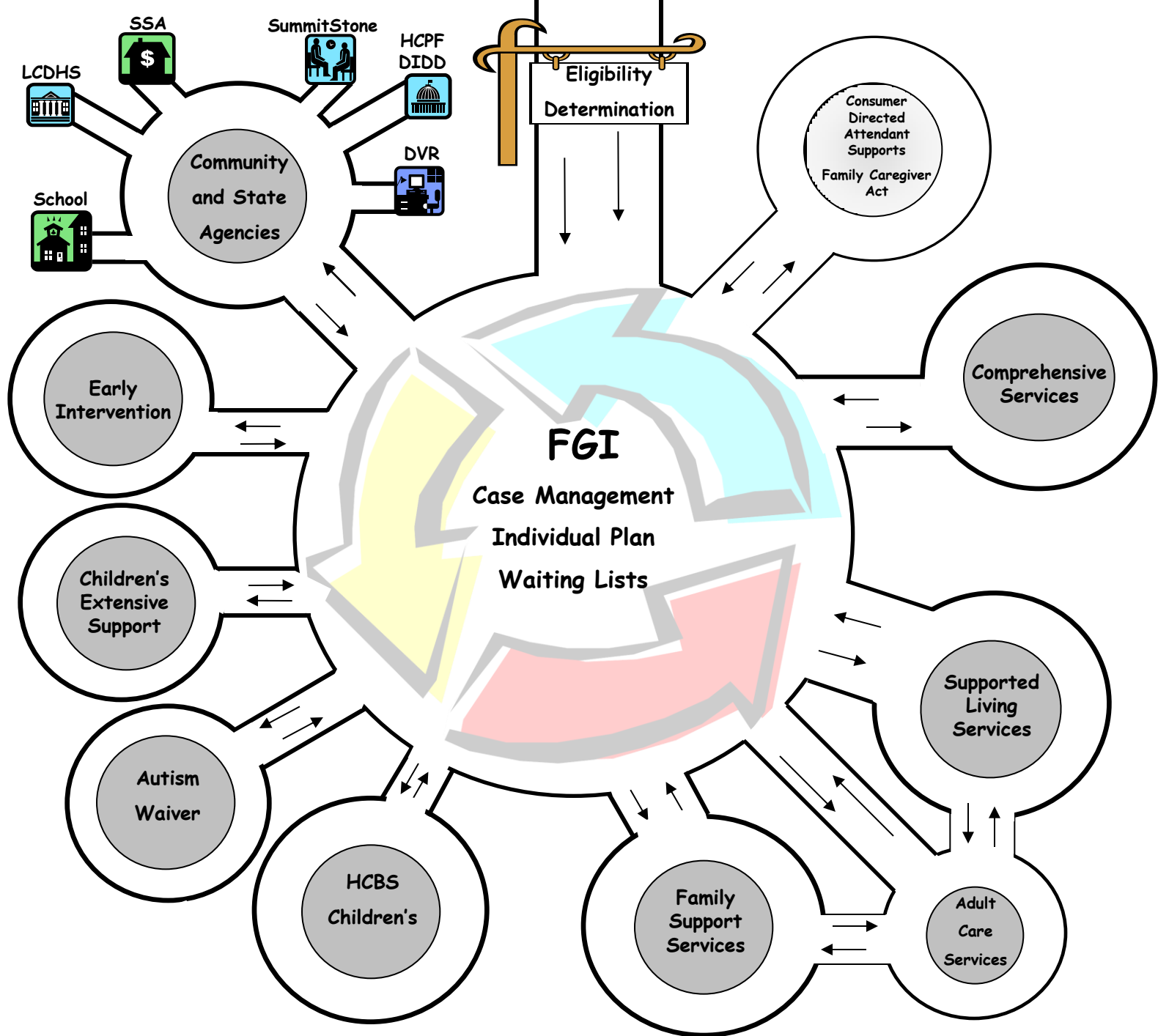

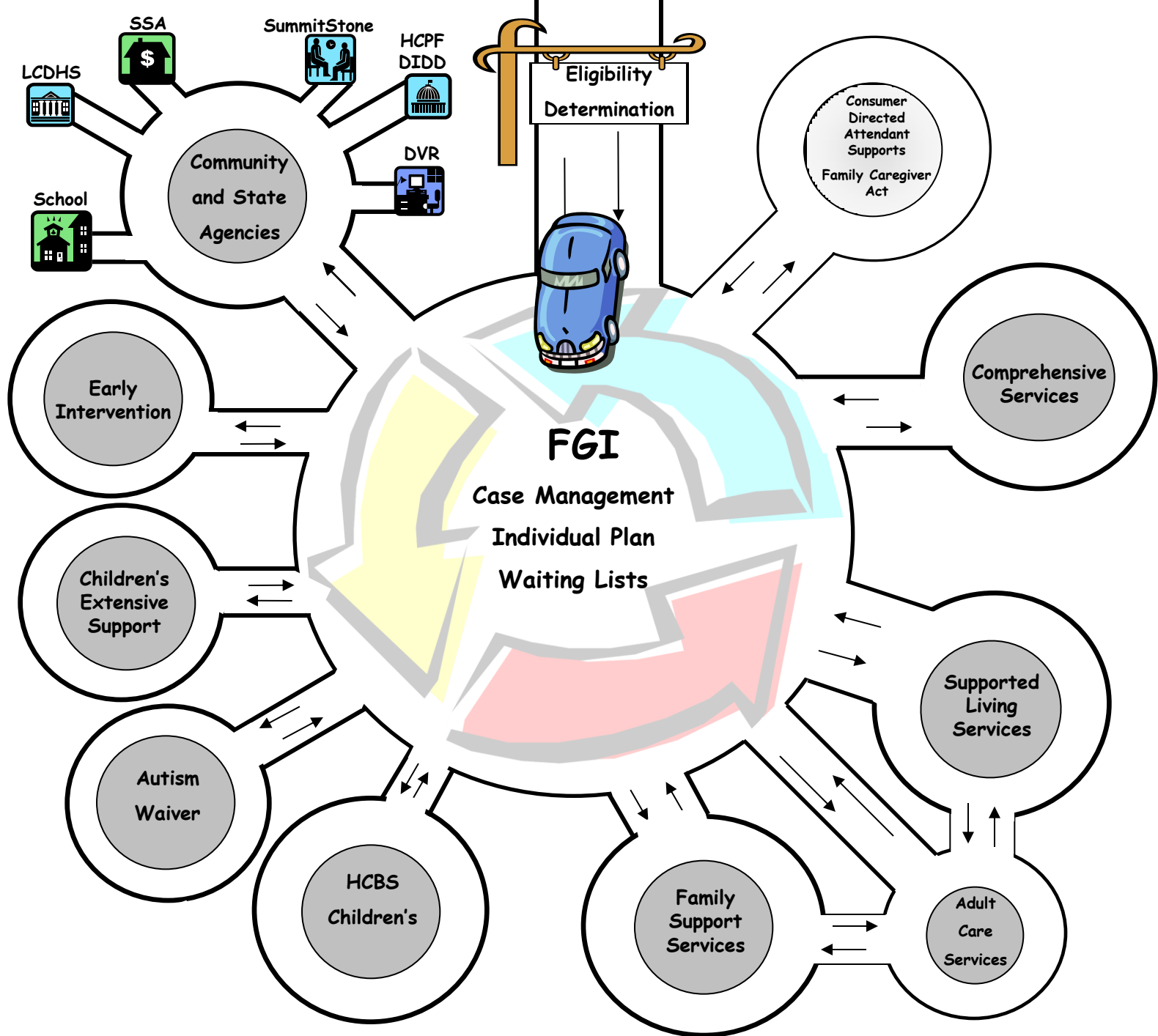


Eligibility for Division for Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (DIDD)

- Determined by a Community Centered Board (CCB), such as Foothills Gateway
- Developmental Delay for ages 0-5
- Developmental Disability for age 5 and older
 - Requires cognitive and adaptive skill deficits
- Eligibility transfers within the State

DIDD Eligibility Dates

- DIDD Eligibility Date - Date first determined eligible in the DDD system
- Order of Selection Date - Date first determined eligible or 14th birthday if have prior DIDD eligibility date
 - Dates are used for waiting list placement
 - Dates transfer within the State



Case Management Waiting List Services

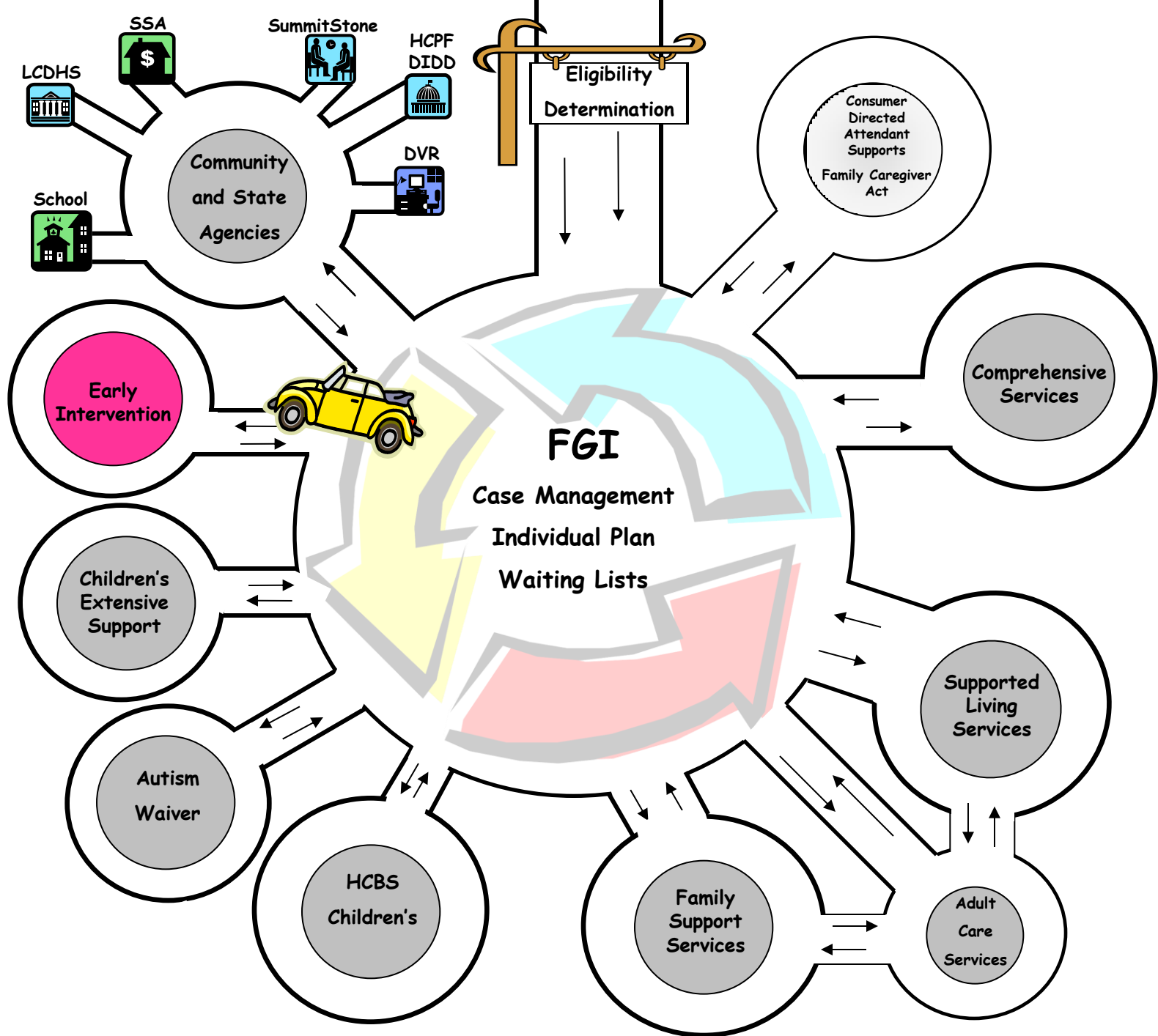
- Develop Waiting List Individual Plan
- Assess functional eligibility for Long Term Care (LTC)
- Refer to Waiting Lists
- Educate and plan for DIDD Adult Services
- Advocate for individual / family
 - Attend IEP/Foster Care reviews
 - Referrals for volunteers
 - Help with guardianship
 - Community resource information / referral

DIDD Waiting List

- Wait List "needs" are documented in Individual Plan and decisions made for wait list referrals
- Must be age 14 to be on the wait list for adult services.
- No age requirement for Family Support Services (must live in family home)
- Can be on wait list for multiple programs
 - Family Support, Supported Living Services, Comprehensive.
- Can only be on one Community Center Board wait list at a time

DIDD Waiting List...continued

- Timeline designated for each wait list, options are:
 - As soon as available
 - Safety net
 - A specific date
- Can change timeline at any time
- Services offered only to persons with "as soon as available" timelines



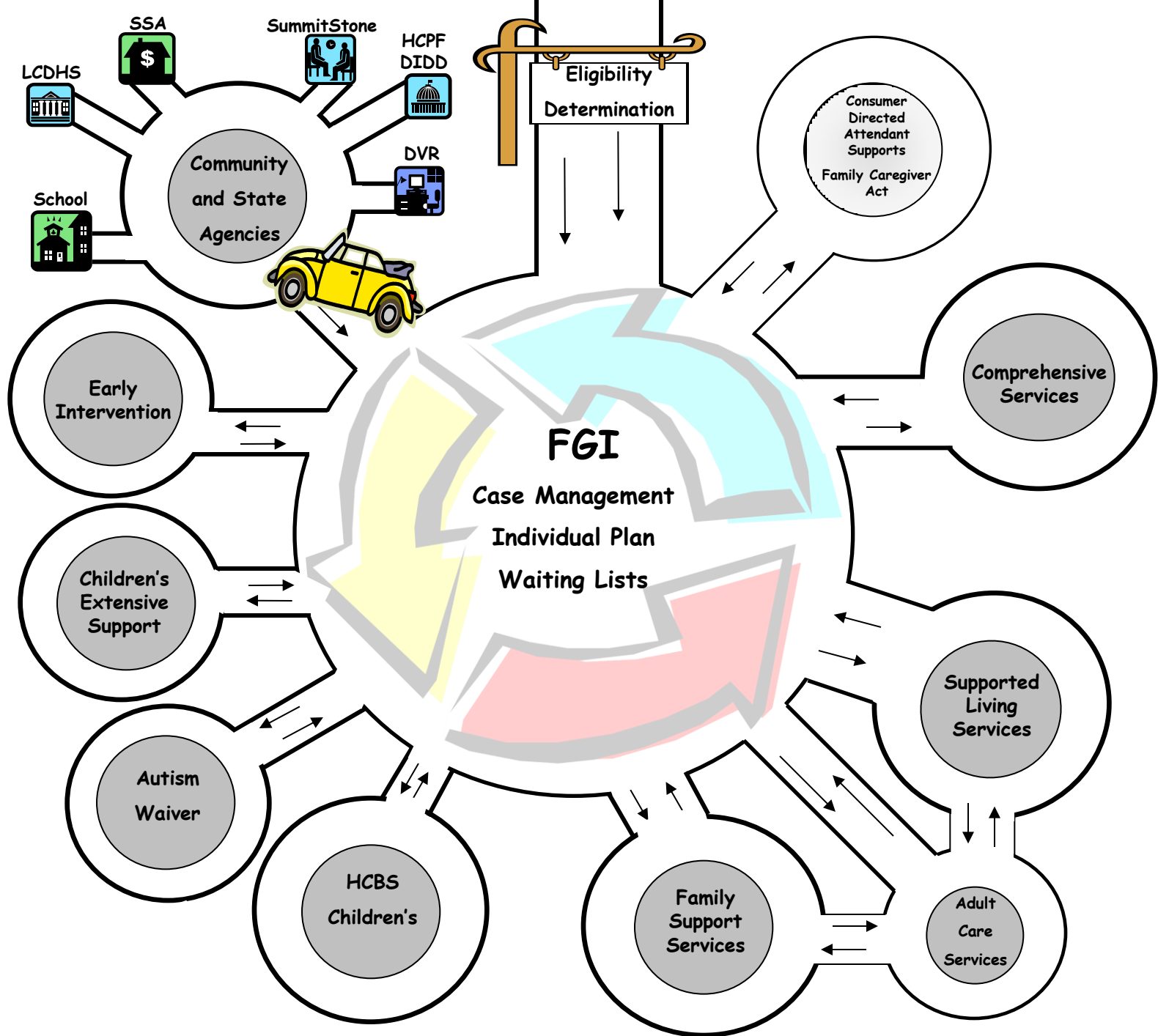
Early Intervention Services

Eligibility Criteria

- Ages: Birth to 3rd birthday
- Developmental delay or disability

Provides

- Service Coordination
- Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP)
- Therapies, parent education, developmental services

Eligibility

Different for each Agency

- Eligibility for:
 - Division for Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (DIDD)
 - Social Security Benefits
 - Medicaid
 - Long Term Care (Functional Eligibility 100.2)
 - Some programs have specific requirements regarding eligibility

DIDD - Division for Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities

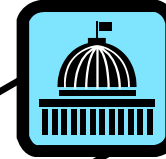

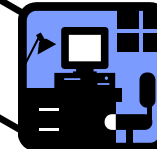

Eligibility for Social Security Benefits

- Determined by Social Security Administration
- Must have a "disability" as determined by Disability Determination Services (DDS)
- At age 18, person applies for benefits based on their individual disability
 - Requires documentation of cognitive, physical and medical disability
- Disability determination is based on ability to work in a competitive employment environment

Types of Social Security Benefits

- Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Eligibility provides Medicaid Health Insurance
 - Current maximum is \$733.00 a month
 - Wages can affect amount received
- Social Security Disability Income (SSDI)
 - Eligibility provides Medicare Health Insurance
 - Person can be eligible based on work history
 - Person may be eligible based on parents retirement, disability or death
 - Amount received is dependent upon amount paid into the Social Security System
- Person can receive both SSI and SSDI at same time, dependent upon amount of SSDI

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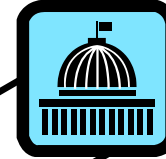

Eligibility for Medicaid

- Determined by Department of Human Services
 - Ways to be eligible....
 - Receive SSI
 - HCBS Waiver Programs
 - 300 % Rule
 - Medicaid eligibility requirements are:
 - Assets less than \$2000
 - Income less than \$1922.00 a month
 - Re-determined every year
 - Expectation that individual/family maintains Medicaid Eligibility

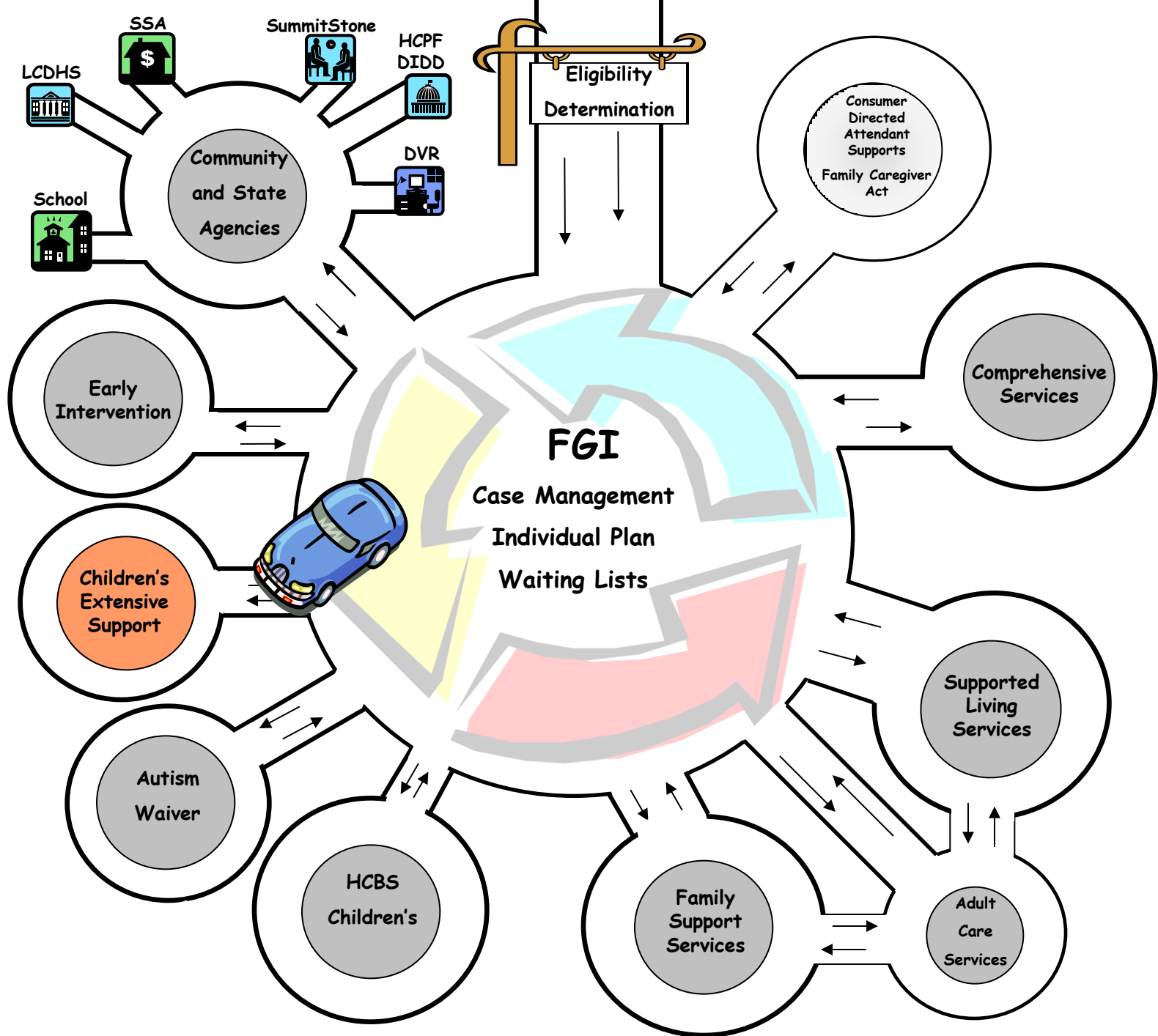


Eligibility for Long Term Care

- Long Term Care (LTC) - a term used to describe services that are alternatives to nursing homes
- For DDD, Long Term Care Services are:
 - HCBS-DD - Comprehensive Waiver
 - HCBS-SLS - Supported Living Services Waiver
 - HCBS-CES - Children's Extensive Support Waiver

Health Care Policy and Financing

- HCBS-CWA -Autism Waiver (ages 0-6)
- HCBS - Children's Waiver
- Case Managers complete a LTC 100.2 assessment
 - Assesses amount of assistance/supervision person needs for daily living and independent living skills
 - Completed LTC 100.2 is reviewed and re-determined yearly



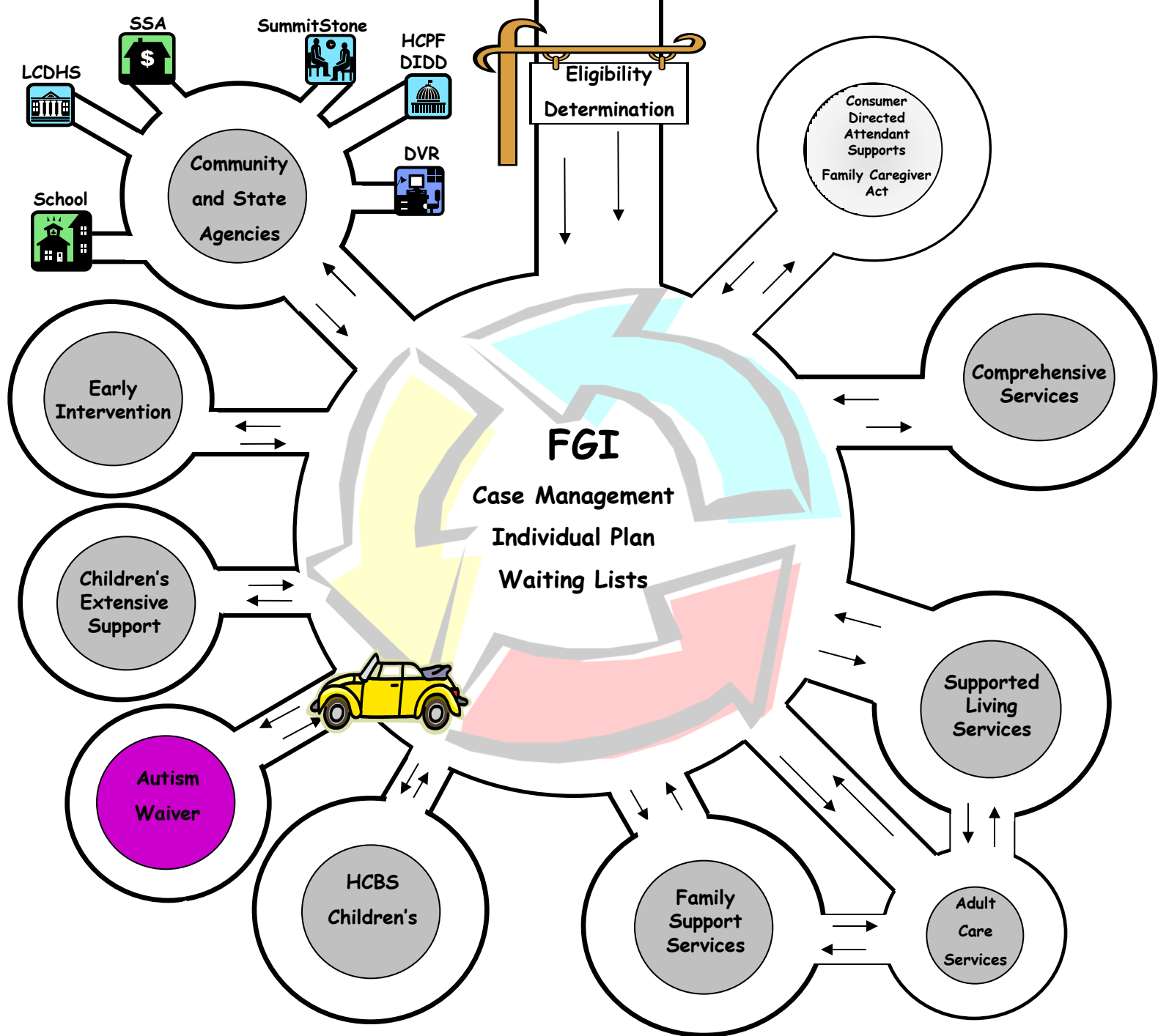
Children's Extensive Support Waiver (CES)

Eligibility Criteria

- Birth to 18th birthday
- Long Term Care eligible
- Requires extensive support/supervision 20 out of 24 hours

Provides

- Medicaid
- Personal Care Assistance (respite, supervision)
- Professional Services
- Home Modification



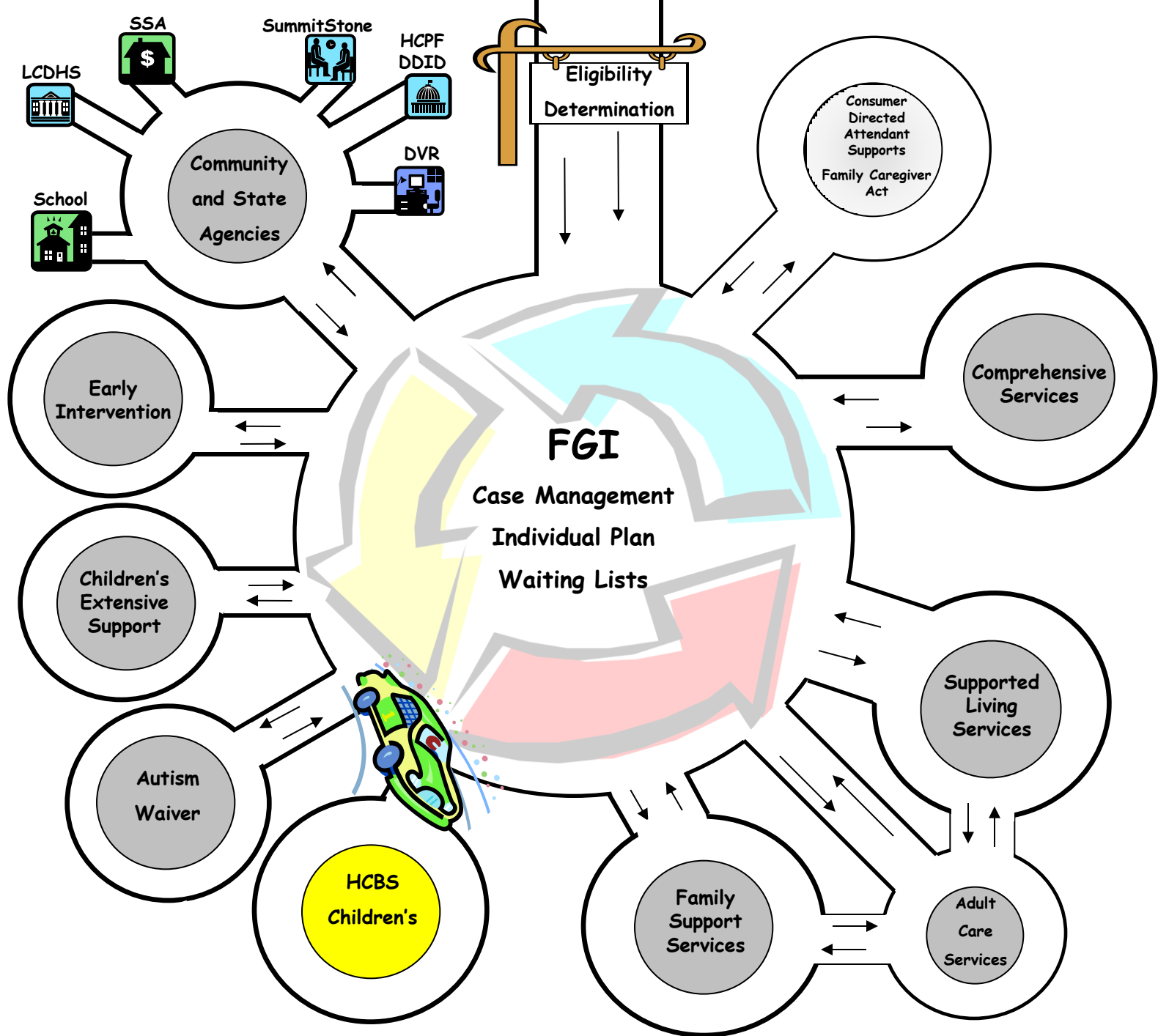
Children's Waiver for Autism (CWA)

Eligibility Criteria

- Birth to 6th birthday
- Long Term Care eligible
- Medical diagnosis of Autism

Provides

- Medicaid
- Behavior Therapy



Children's Home and Community Based Services (C-HCBS)

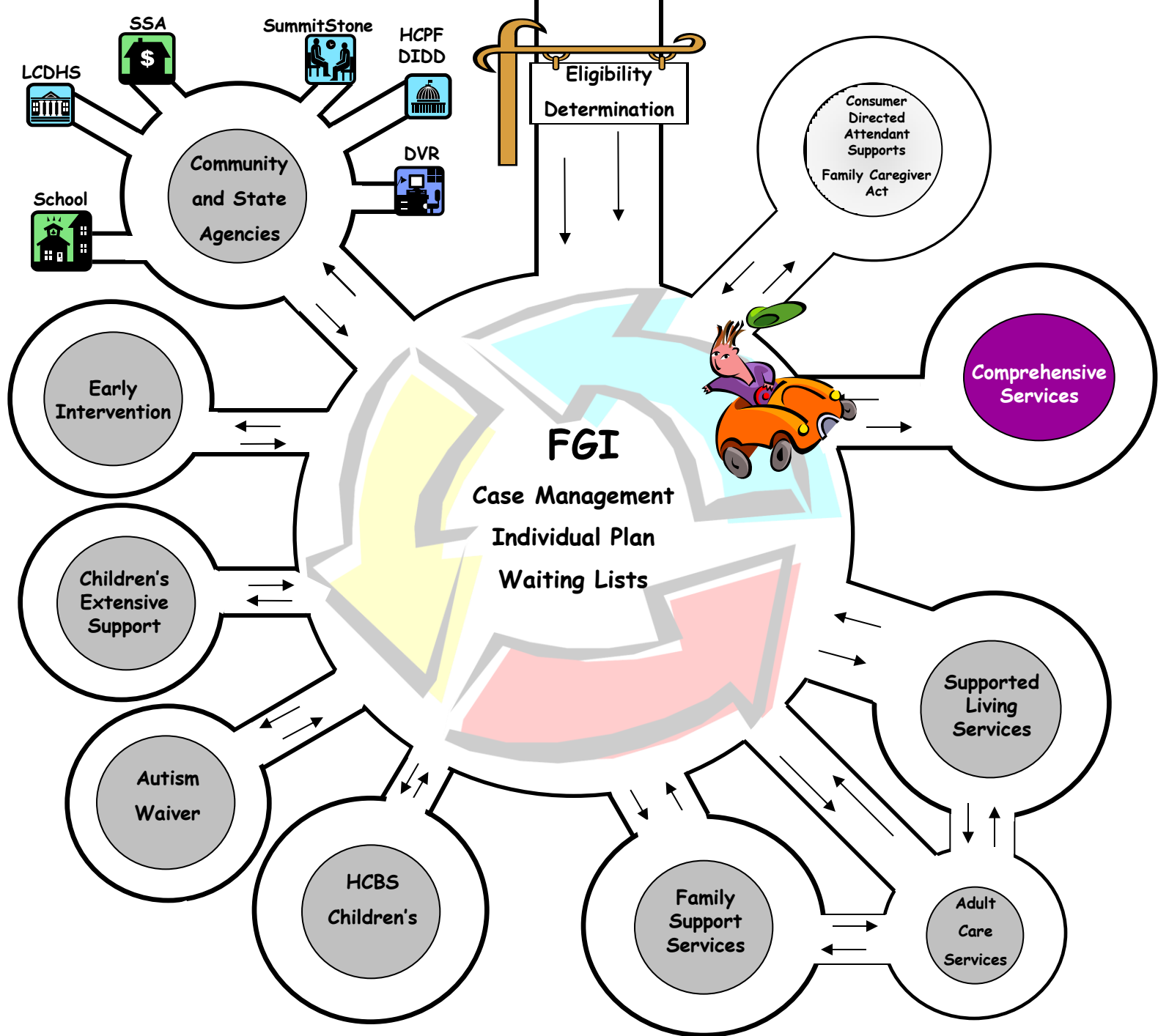
Eligibility Criteria

- Birth to 18th birthday
- Long Term Care eligible – medically fragile
- Parent's must be over income for SSI

Provides

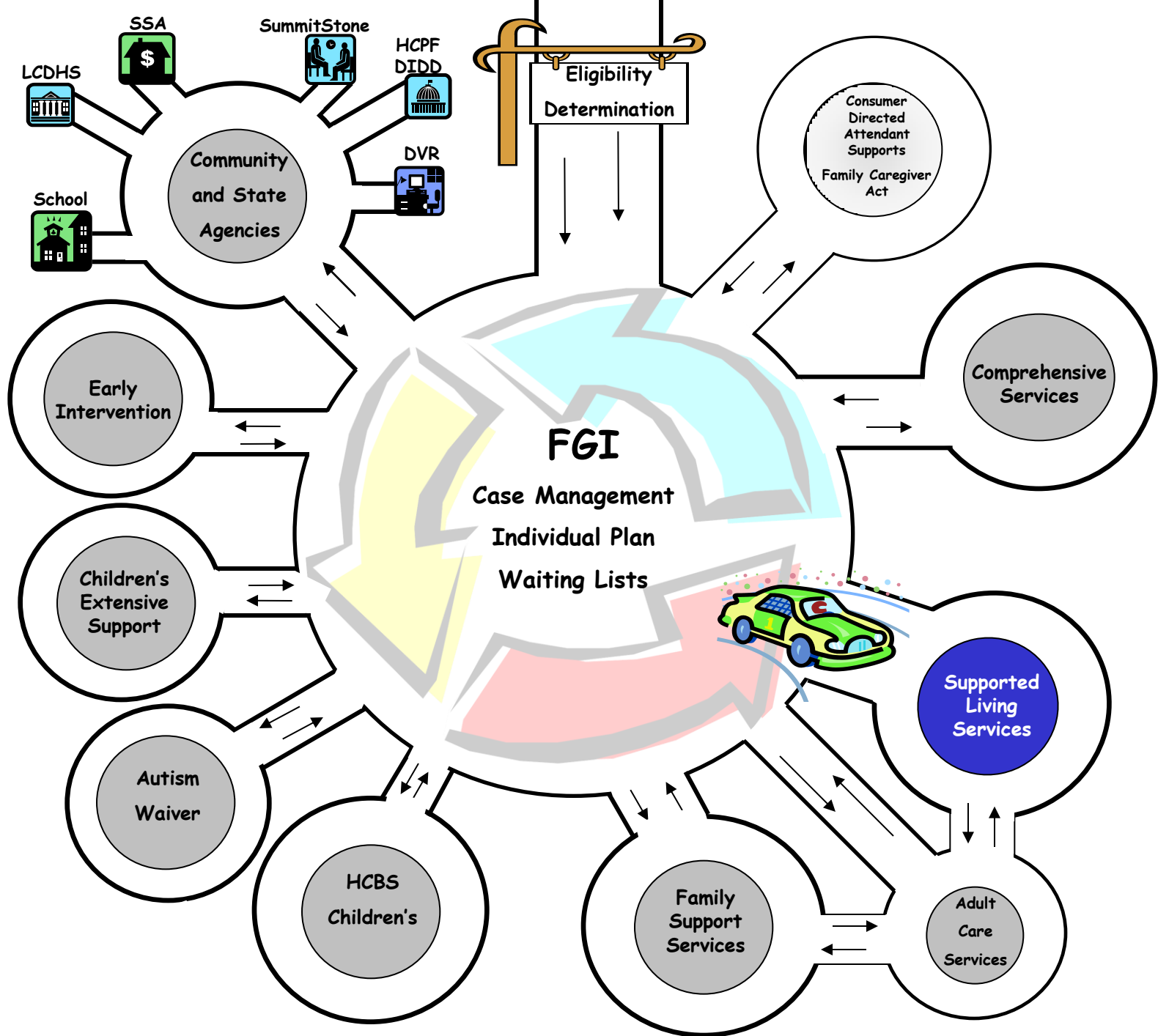
- Case Management
- Medicaid

❖ Does not require DDD eligibility



HCBS-DD Comprehensive Waiver

- Provides residential services and supports
 - Group homes
 - Host homes
 - Apartments
 - Companion settings
- Habilitation services may include hygiene, money management, supervision, cooking, community access
- Provides integrated or non-integrated vocational or community participation activities
- Provides transportation to and from day habilitation and vocational services



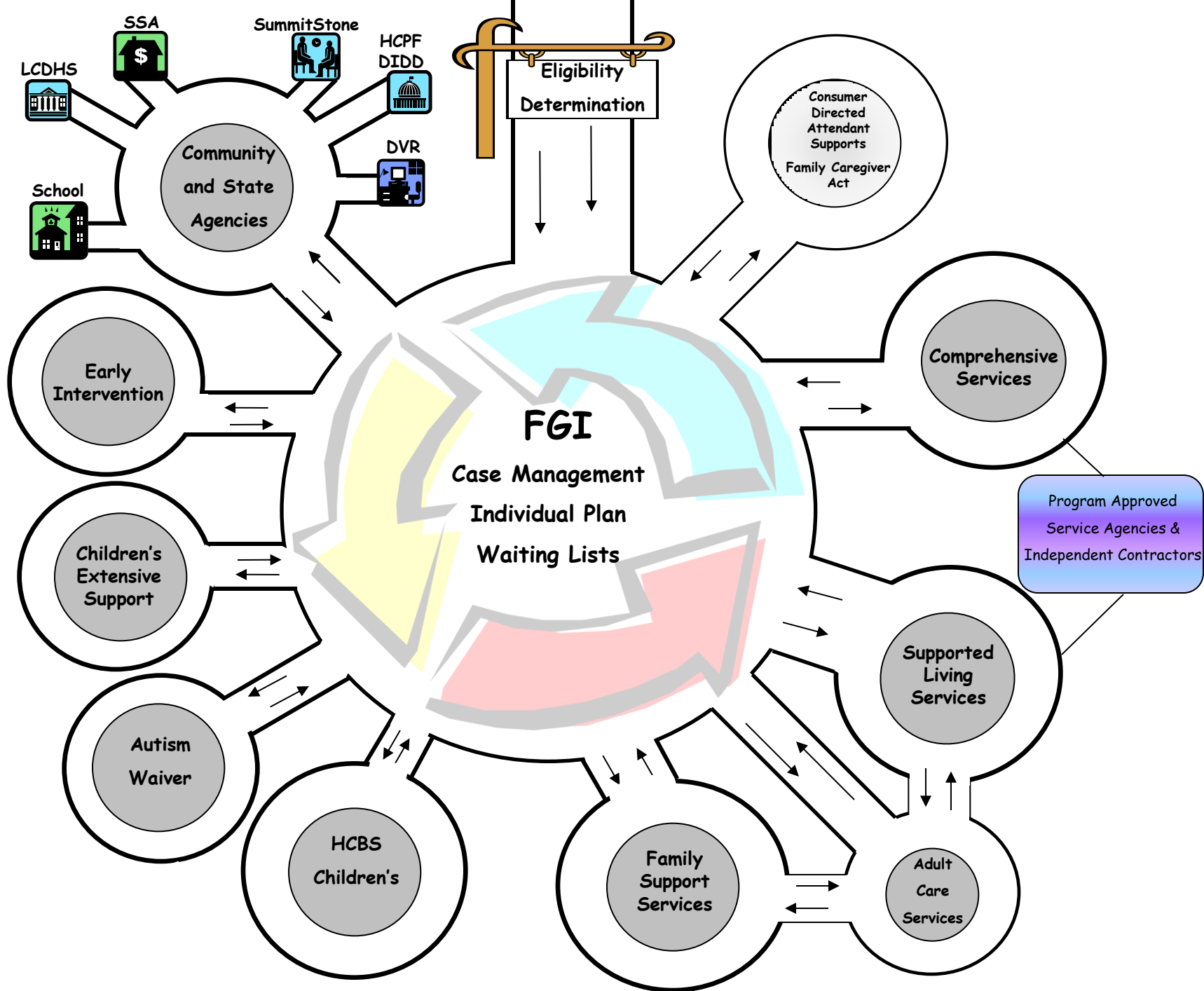
Supported Living Services Waiver

- Provides services and supports in the family home or in an independent setting
- Personal Care
- Homemaker
- Mentorship
- Respite
- Professional Services (massage, hippo-therapy, movement)
- Dental and Vision Services
- Supported Community Connections
- Specialized Medical Equipment and Supplies
- Home Accessibility Adaptations and Vehicle Modifications
- Personal Emergency Response System
- Supported Employment Services
- Non-Medical Transportation
- Behavioral Services
- Assistive technology
- Day Habilitation - Specialized Habilitation

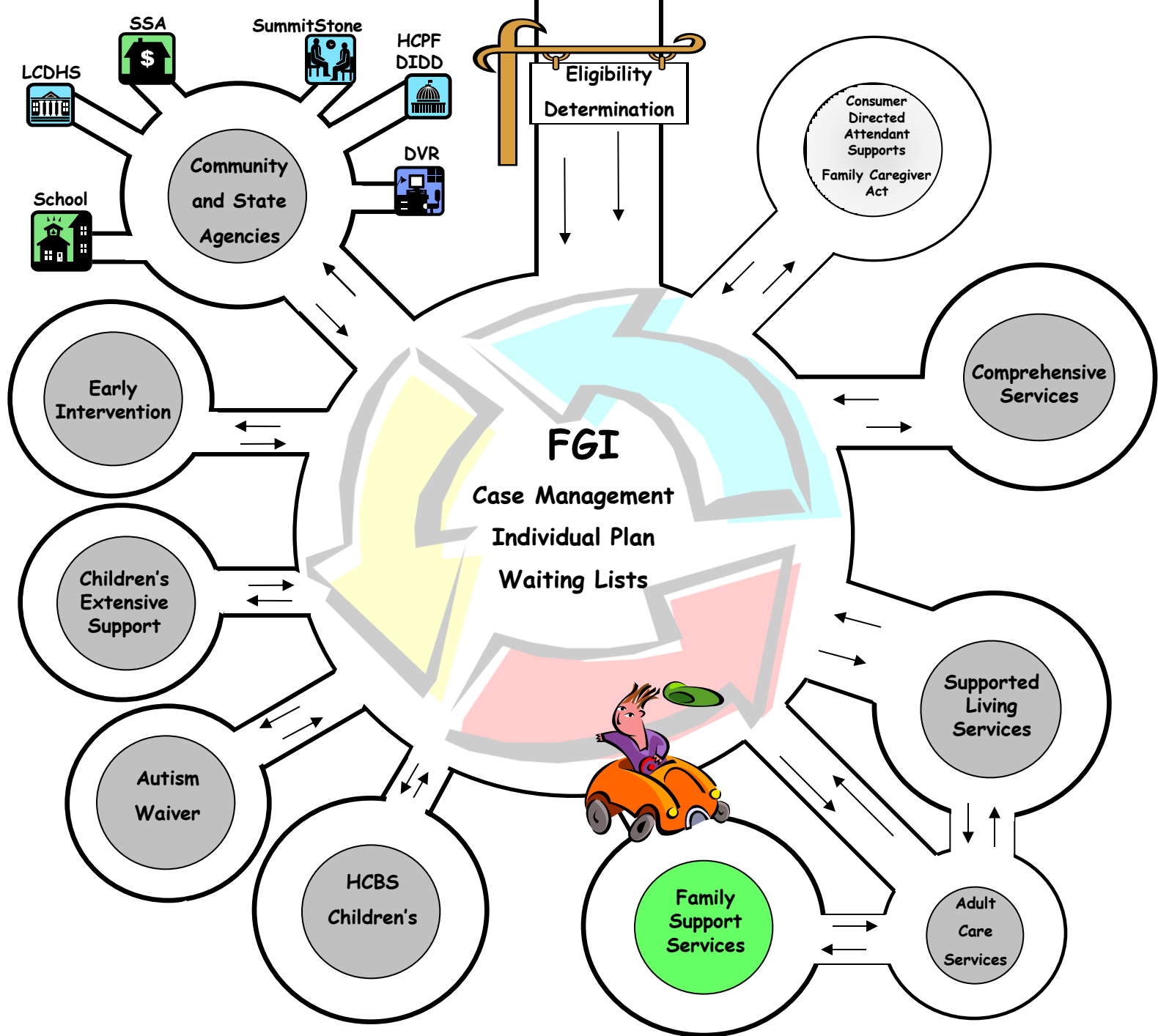

Family Support Services Program (FSSP)

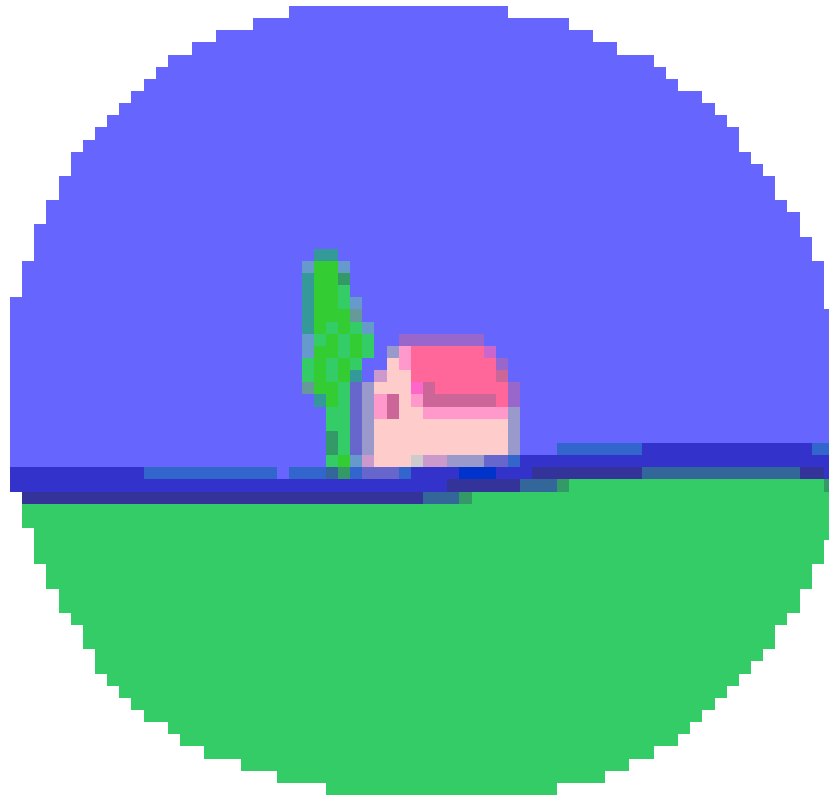
Eligibility Criteria

- Birth to death, as long as living in the family home
- Developmental delay before age 5, intellectual disability after age 5

Provides

- Case Management
- Funding to families to help with costs related to disability
