FINANCIAL REPORT

• Carla Conrardy presented the unaudited statement of financial position for the nine months ending March 31, 2023. *Detailed financial information can be found in the Board Meeting packets, which are posted to the Foothills Gateway website.*

• Case Management Redesign (CMRD) Next Steps

Case Management Agency (CMA) RFPs had to be submitted to the state by February 28th. Proposals are under review, and this is considered the 'quiet period'. Bidders/offerors cannot discuss the RFP until after the awardees have been notified.

The rollout of the new Care and Case Management (CCM) data system, which is supposed replace the legacy case management data systems, has been delayed. The original transition was supposed to happen in March and was postponed until sometime in April.

Colorado Department of Health Care Policy & Financing (HCPF) has been meeting with stakeholders to revise rules and regulations for the Case Management Agencies and had planned to have all the revisions completed and approved by the Medical Services Board in September 2023. However, the revised rules will not be approved and implemented until January 2024.

• Change Management

Due to the significance of the changes generated by Case Management Redesign, Foothills Gateway has retained local consultants to facilitate Change Management Workshops with our employees. In April/May, Management Team, the Case Management Division, Administrative Division, and a section of Direct Services Division will participate in the workshop sessions with the goal of increasing skills and strategies to manage change. We are also developing a recorded version with a virtual discussion component that will be rolled out to Direct Support Professionals (DSPs) and other staff who are not able to make an in-person training.

• Home Care Agency Survey

On the Tuesday after Spring Break, a Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE) program quality surveyor arrived at Foothills Gateway to complete an unannounced program quality survey of our Home Care Agency program. The surveyor was complimentary of the agency and program and complimented the staff on being well-organized. The surveyor reviewed the 5 deficiencies he was able to identify and told the staff that it's unusual to have so few deficiencies – the average number of deficiencies for other agencies runs between 8 to 15 deficiencies.

• Staff Updates

Reni Moreno, our Cross System Crisis Response and START (Systemic, Therapeutic, Assessment, Resources, and Treatment) Coordinator, has been recognized by the National Center for START Services at the University of New Hampshire for the 2023 START Team Member Award for the states providing START Services (California, Colorado, Iowa, Texas, Tennessee, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, New York, and New Hampshire)! Jackie O'Riordan, Program Administrator for Day Habilitation programs, will be retiring on June 30th after 32 years of service to individuals, families and Foothills Gateway!

- Debbie Klein
 - Community Centered Board (CCB) designation application was submitted this week, the results will be known by May 15th. Next year the CCB application will be completely different and will be good for ten years.
 - **Health benefits renewal** There was a 4% increase this year, the increase will be split between FGI and staff.
 - **Unconscious Bias Training** All staff who perform on interview teams or hire staff have been trained in Unconscious Bias. Staff have given very positive feedback on both the trainer and the content of the training.
 - Flying Pig 5k is scheduled for this Sunday, April 23rd
 - **Taste of Loveland -** will be May 4th, tickets can be purchased on FGI's website.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

- **Executive Committee** Mark Durand shared that the Executive Committee met on April 7, 2023 and discussed the Board Meeting Agenda Review and the Officer Updates given above.
- Fiscal and Property Committee Aaron Vogt shared that the Fiscal and Property Committee met prior to this meeting and discussed the designation of a \$5,000 donation from Karel Applebee to the Bright Start Program, Financial Statement review YTD March and the Quarterly Investment Report.
- Legislative Affairs Ron shared that the Legislative Affairs Committee met on April 14th and discussed the State Budget Update, Alliance Legislative Updates and Policy Priorities.
