She demonstrates reliability, caring, and compassion each and every day. Liz is a hard worker, she also works on the START Crisis Response Team, responding to calls for people with IDD who are having behavioral health issues, in addition to her full-time work in Day Habilitation. Liz, like many FGI staff, has shown her caring and dependability throughout the pandemic by ensuring people living in host homes had access to activities and projects by putting together activity packages and working with them in their homes. Once day program was ready to re-open, Liz was more than ready to greet the people returning to day program and welcome them back to their programs. Liz is an extraordinary advocate, and she invests her time and attention in meeting each person's specific needs.


